How we use your information:

Forth Environment Link is collecting your information so that we can monitor the electric bike loan and contact you to gather feedback on your experience. This information may be shared with Scottish Government and your Local Authority to help them improve and inform policy and target funding.

We will email you to ask for your feedback on your experience of this service to help us improve it. We will do this shortly after you return the bike, and then follow up a few months later to see if you have considered buying an electric bike and ask if you are interested in any of the other services the Hub can provide (cycle training, bike maintenance, route planning, buddy rides, further use of the electric bike library etc).

Terms & Conditions of e-Bike Loan

- 1. I am responsible for the security of any HES bicycle loaned to me. I will take care of the bicycle that I am provided with, locking it up whenever it is left unattended, with the lock provided. I will remove the battery from the electric bike each time I leave the bike unattended.
- 2. I will not abuse any Forth Environment Link bicycle loaned to me; in particular, I will not use an FEL bicycle for racing, stunt or trick riding or for any purpose other than cycling to and from a destination.
- 3. I am responsible for the maintenance of any Forth Environment Link bicycle loaned to me. I will maintain the bicycle that I am provided with in a safe and roadworthy condition for the period of the loan. If a fault develops and I am unable to keep the bike in a safe and roadworthy condition, I will return the bicycle to FEL within the agreed term of loan stated above.
- 4. I will let FEL know if for any reason the bicycle is not being used.
- 5. If the bicycle is lost or stolen, I will report this to the police and to FEL as soon as possible.
- 6. I will return the loaned bicycle in good condition along with all bike accessories equipped, including "Gold" insurance bike lock.
- 7. I agree to not allow any persons under the age of 14 years old to ride the loaned bicycle in public areas or roads (including off-road cycle paths and public parks) in accordance with UK road safety law and EU regulation 168/2013.
- 8. I understand and agree that prior to my bicycle loan, the bike was in full working order and has had all maintenance checks required.
- 9. Forth Environment Link is not responsible for any injury or any loss or damage to any property resulting from the use of the bicycle. FEL takes no responsibility whatsoever for any injury or any loss or damage to any property which occurs when using a loan bicycle. I take full responsibility for any such injury, loss or damage to any property or to any person which occurs as a result of my loaned bicycle.
- 10. I agree not to make any modifications to the loaned bicycle other than the standard 'bike fit' alterations i.e. saddle height. If I wish to modify the loaned bicycle in any other way then I will discuss this with Stirling Active Travel Hub prior to taking the bike away. I agree that any modifications will be carried out on my behalf by a professional bicycle mechanic. A receipt of this work will be provided to Stirling Active Travel Hub for their records. If damage is caused as a result of any modifications, authorised or unauthorised, then I will be wholly responsible for any costs incurred to repair the loaned bicycle.
- 11. I will complete a survey and provide feedback after the return of the electric bike.
